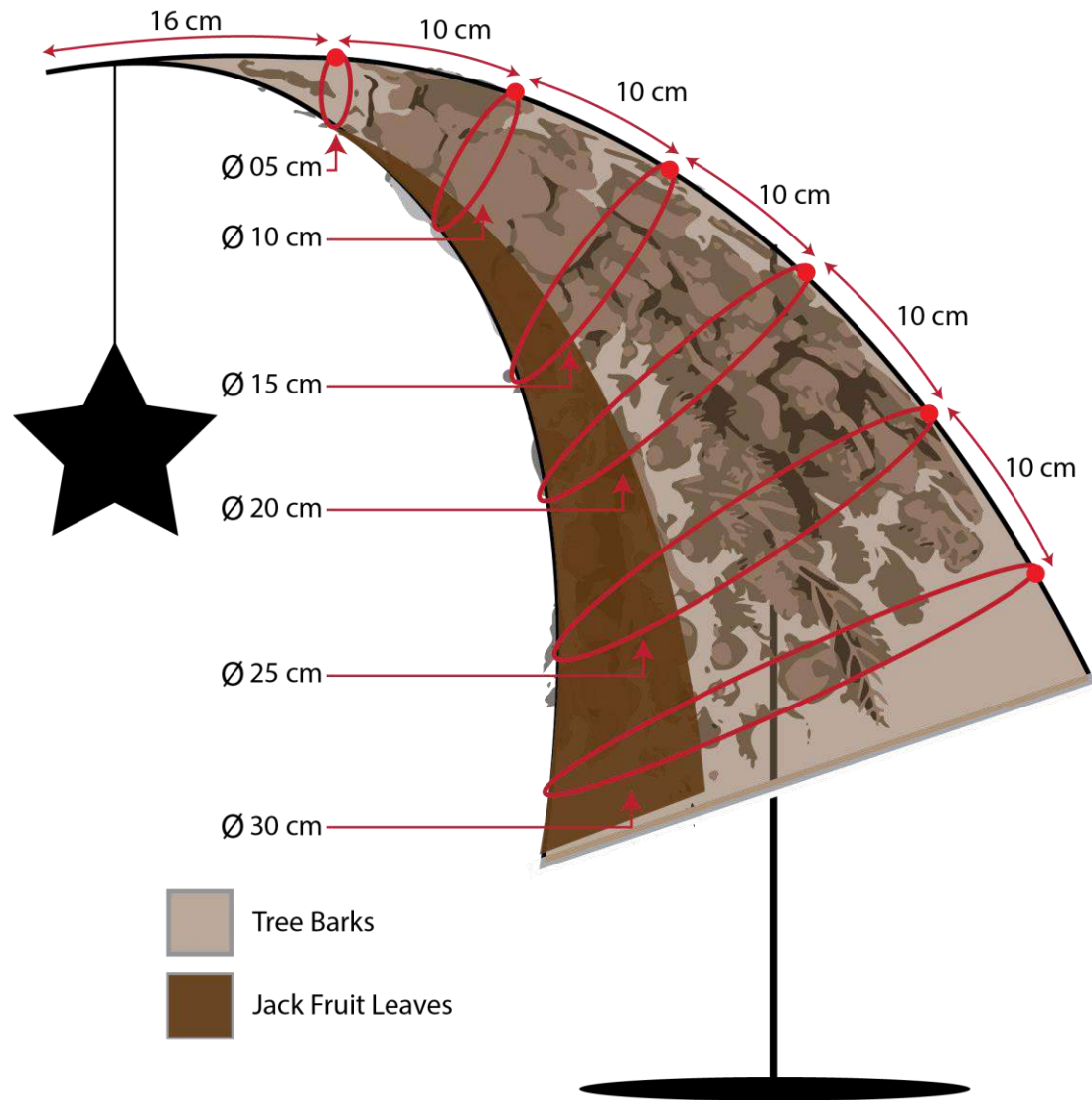

INITIAL SKETCH OF THE PLAN

PROCEDURE_CHRISTMAS TREE

Step 01_Basic structure of the design



Used Bamboo sticks as the base.

Step 02_Body of the design



Attached the tree barks and Jackfruit leaves to the design's body. And the leaves' edges were cut by zig-zag scissors to give an aesthetic look.

PROCEDURE_CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS PART I

Poinsettias



Onion peels were transformed into poinsettia flowers, with the serrated edges of the petals carefully crafted by burning them with incense.

Christmas Balls



Collected fallen pinecones, which will eventually decompose, were transformed into Christmas balls using dried wildflowers and sack yarns and painted pinecones white for a snowy look.

Angels were made using straws, pistachio peels, and fallen feathers from birds.

The Star of Bethlehem



The Star of Bethlehem was made using bamboo sticks, sack yarn, and sackcloth.

Aesthetic- Earthy tones and natural textures create an authentic look.

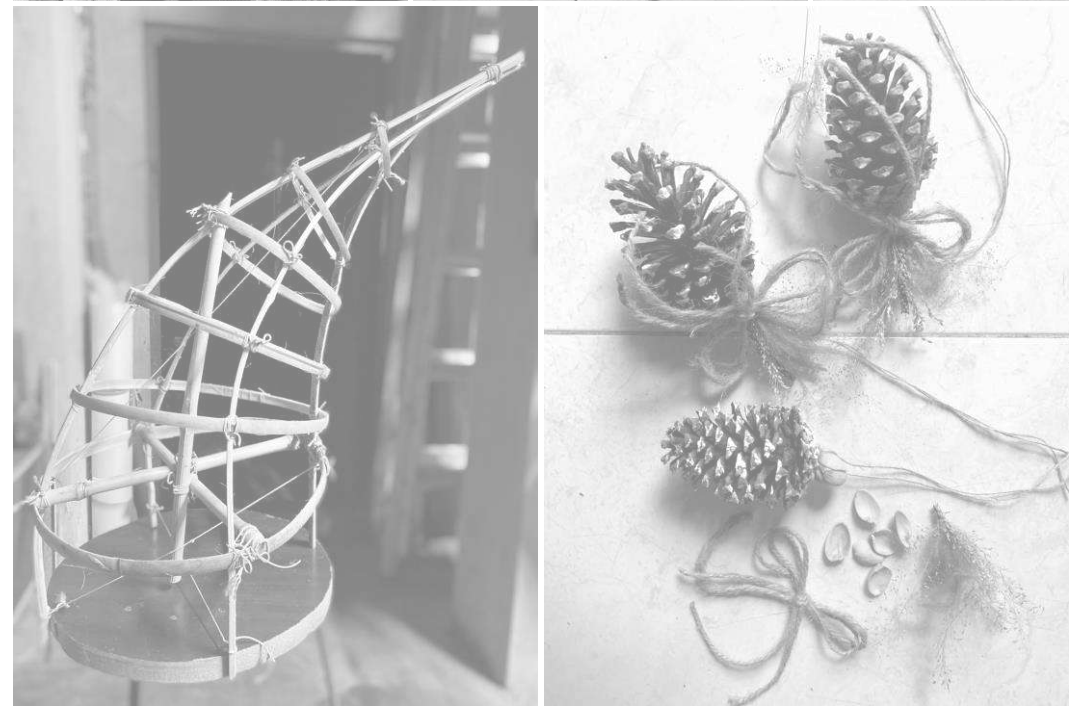
Accessibility- Sourced from readily available, low-cost resources.

BUDGET OVERVIEW

Material	Cost
Tree Barks, Leaves, Moss, Pinecones	Free (collected)
Onion Peels, Pistachio Shells, Sackcloth	From household waste
Bamboo Sticks	Repurposed
Paint, Glue and Sack Yarn	Use existing supplies
